

DIG QSO-Party Kurzwelle

Rules valid since 2025



1. Contest period and frequencies

1.a Phone (SSB)

Second full weekend in march.

Saturday, 1200 – 1700 UTC, 14125 – 14300, 21151 – 21450, 28320 – 28700 kHz

Sunday, 0700 – 0900 UTC, 3600 – 3650 und 3700 – 3800 kHz

0900 – 1100 UTC, 7060 – 7100 und 7130 – 7200 kHz

1.b Telegraphy (CW)

Second full weekend in april.

Saturday, 1200 – 1700 UTC, 14000 – 14060, 21000 – 21070, 28000 – 28070 kHz

Sunday, 0700 – 0900 UTC, 3510 – 3560 kHz

0900 – 1100 UTC, 7000 – 7040 kHz

2. Participants

All licensed radio amateurs and SWLs are welcome.

3. Exchange

Call “CQ DIG”, exchange: RS(T) and DIG-Membership number.

Non-members report RS(T) only. Stations may be contacted once on each band.

4. Scoring

Phone, Telegraphy and SWLs are scored separately.

Each QSO with DIG member counts 10 points,

each QSO with non-member counts 1 point.

5. Multiplier

A multiplier of one for each DIG member. Each DIG member counts only once regardless of worked bands.

A multiplier of one for each worked country (DXCC and WAE list) on each band.

6. Final score

Sum of all QSO points of all bands multiplied by multiplier (sum of countries and worked DIG members).

7. Participation of SWL

Each QSO between two DIG members counts 10 points.

Each QSO between DIG member and non DIG member counts 1 point.

Only 10 contacts per DIG member are allowed to be logged.

8. Awards

The winner will receive an engraved cup.

The winner of each country from where are more than ten logs submitted will receive a special DIG trophy.

Also the YL with best result of each contest part will receive a special DIG trophy.

All participants have the possibility to download their certificate in PDF format (<https://dig-contest.de>).

Rules valid since 2024



1. Contest period and frequencies

Second saturday in may, 1300 – 1600 UTC, 144 MHz Band

1300 – 1600 UTC, 432 MHz Band

All modes (CW, SSB, FM) on direct frequencies.

2. Participants

All licensed radio amateurs and SWLs are welcome.

3. Exchange

Call "CQ DIG", exchange: RS(T), DIG-Membership number and QTH Locator.

Non-members report RS(T) and QTH Locator only. Stations may be contacted once on each band.

4. Scoring

Every band is scored separately. Each kilometer covered counts as one point.

5. Multiplier

A multiplier of one for each DIG member.

6. Final score

Sum of all QSO points multiplied by sum of worked DIG members.

7. Awards

The winner will receive an engraved cup.

The winner of each country from where are more than ten logs submitted will receive a special DIG trophy.

Also the YL with best result of each contest part will receive a special DIG trophy.
